

# Siniat EasyLite plaster

# **Description**

Siniat EasyLite is a gypsum plaster-based product designed to level uneven internal surfaces and to smooth levelled surfaces for a superior and smooth finished result. It is a lightweight all-in-one lightweight plaster.

### Intended use

Application onto the following surfaces:

- Plasterboard
- Sand and cement plastered walls
- Concrete slabs and soffit
- **Brick surfaces**

### Caution

  - Siniat multipurpose (blue bag) is used in interior part of the country
  - o Siniat Skimming plaster (yellow bag) for **coastal** is used in the coastal regions
- It is not made for human consumption
- Keep out of reach of children
- Keep your workplace ventilated
- Use PPE for protection

## Finishing suggestion

Siniat EasyLite (blue bag) is finished off with a rubber float to bring out the excess EasyLite and to smoothen it.

Siniat EasyLite plaster needs to be primed before applying paint, please consult your painting supplier for a suitable plaster primer.

Variance from the application instructions will result in dust or residue on the surface after set and dry time is completed, applying a primer will assist against potential delamination of finishing materials, due to deviance from the application and cleaning instructions. It is important that you adhere to the application instructions as stipulated.

## Storage:

- Store Siniat EasyLite inside, on a level surface, off the floor, in a dry place protected from the weather.
- Moisture is to be avoided. Open bags that still contain product are to be sealed tightly to avoid dust spreading and to protect the product.
- Care should be taken when lifting single bags of plaster by hand to ensure that back injuries do not occur. Pallets of plaster to be moved by mechanical handling equipment only.

- Rubber float (if needed)
- Steel trowel
- Block brush
- PPE
